



IVNGWC 2008 CHALLENGE RULES

Welcome to the Inventor News Group World Cup 2008 challenge!

The deadline for this challenge is the 21st day of each challenge month. Judging should be complete by the end of the same month. New challenges should be available by the 5th of each month.

You will get points on the scoreboard just for trying, and zero points for not letting us know you've tried thus giving you a zero on the scoreboard.

Setup note: The drawing sheet will describe the units and projection type.

Follow these simple rules:

- 1 - Print the drawing sheet **AND DON'T LOOK AT IT YET.**
- 2 - Setup your environment (mm or inch, depending on the specification!) and start a new part file.
- 3 - Place the drawing **FACE DOWN**, start the clock, flip the drawing over and model it as fast as possible ending up with a model or assembly with the correct volume at the Accuracy setting 'Very High' (don't just use the 'Update' button without setting the accuracy !) as indicated on the drawing sheet. If Inventor comes up with an alert about the requested accuracy just hit OK.
- 4 - The amount of time spent is from the moment you've seen the drawing until finished, even if it takes more than one go at the solution. You are allowed to stop the clock only if you are forced to get away from the challenge modeling. **Record the time in Hours: Minutes (HH:MM).**
#1 priority: Correct volume of a correct model or assembly with the Physical Properties Accuracy setting 'Very High' (or 'High' after hitting OK in the alert box).
#2 priority: Fastest time.

Let me know how fast you can model it (don't cheat - it's no satisfaction to be the fastest when you know you've cheated. Everybody can cut off at least 50% of the initial time on a second try).

Some contestants have failed to submit times and/or zipped files.

NOTE: Please follow these guidelines before posting files to the website:

- a. - Use Winzip (www.winzip.com) or Winrar (www.rarlab.com) to compact the files.
- b. - **Name the zipfile with your name.**
